CASU Defined – An interagency network of Federal entrepreneurial organizations that provides the full range of support services to Federal agencies, throughout the United States and overseas, on a cost reimbursable basis.

CASU Authority – Network members operate under the authority provided by:

- Economy Act of 1932 as amended (31 U.S.C. 1535)
- Government Management Reform Act, 1994.

The CASU program establishes the legal and administrative framework for CASUs to offer services to government agencies.

CASU Sources - The Network provides 95% of its nationwide services through contracts with the private sector.
